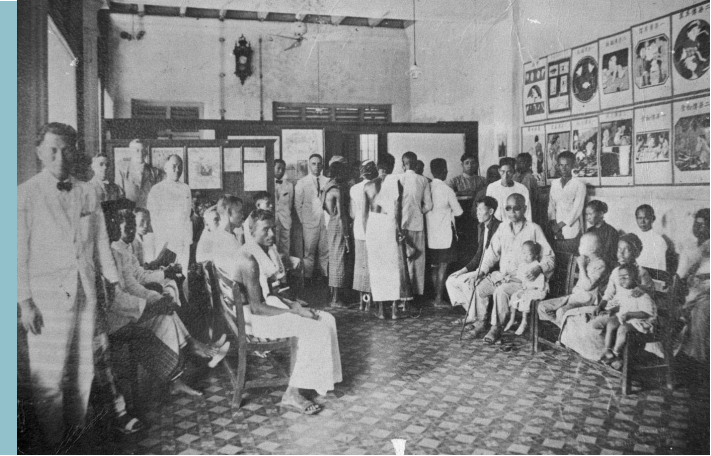

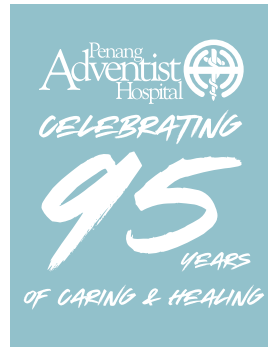

Dr. J Earl Gardner and his wife Ethel first arrived in Penang in 1924, with a mission to provide medical care to all, even for those who could not afford it. On his clinic were the words, "Poor Treated Free".

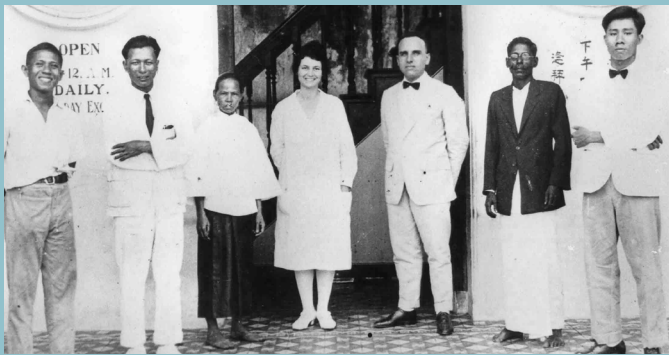
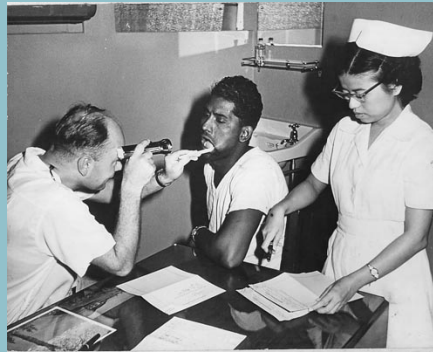
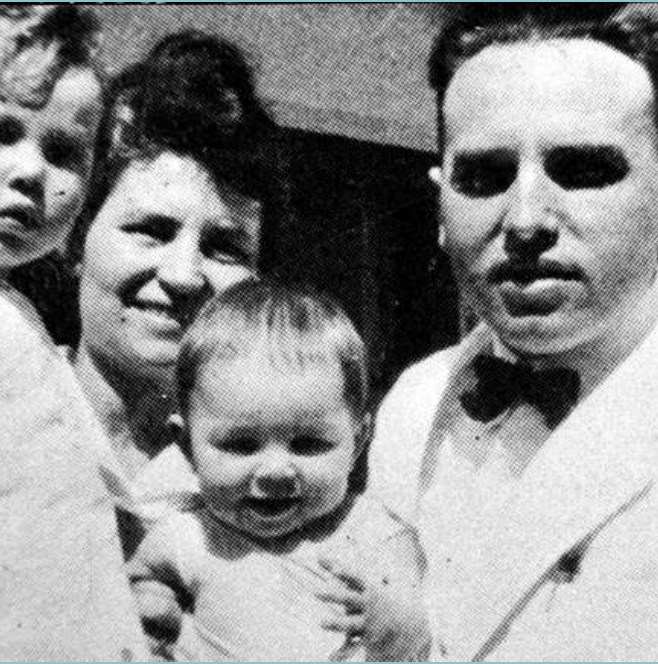

Our mission remains the same today with a different slogan "God Heals, We Help". We continue to play a part in the community through selfless service, reaching out to the poor and needy alike has been a continuous mission-driven journey of the hospital.

The hospital is committed in changing lives and making a difference in our community by providing quality medical care and financial assistance to individuals need. This was Dr. Gardner's dream. CHARITY, THE VOICE OF HOPE

Early years - Sabbath/ Welfare Fund

Income received by the hospital during Sabbath (sunset of Friday to sunset of Saturday) are channelled towards this fund which assists needy patients in dialysis treatment, cataract surgery, minor surgeries and other non-surgical treatments.

1988 - Set up of Patient Heart Fund

The Patient Heart Fund has mended the hearts of children and adult alike since 1988. We are dedicated towards improving the lives of Malaysian suffering from heart diseases, one of the leading causes of death. The fund has since then disbursed more than RM10,600,000.00 given hope and a chance at new lease of life to 771 needy heart patients whose ages ranged from a few weeks to 81 years old.

1997 – Medical Social Services



The hospital's Medical Social Services Unit was established in 1997 to help the poor and needy with financial assistance.

1999 – Gift Of Life Penang Programme

The Gift of Life is a community service project initiated by the Rotary Club of New York District 7250 in 1975. Since its inception, children with heart ailments from many developing countries have received chance at living normal lives and mended hearts.

In 1999, the Gift Of Life Penang programme became a reality in Penang, through a matching grant from Gift of Life Inc. amounting to RM370,000. This is a joint programme between the Rotary Club of Penang District 3300 as well as Penang Adventist Hospital. The hospital was granted as the referral base for all Gift Of Life patients in Southeast Asia. Since 2014 Gift Of Life Penang Programme extend its assistance to needy heart patients of 60 years and below. Till to-date, the Gift Of Life Penang Programme has mended the hearts of 120 needy heart patients and disbursed more than RM1,600,000.00.

2001 – The Wishing Well Project

Legendary to the Gift Of Life Penang Programme, wishing wells were introduced as a fundraising effort. Donors will not only be able to make the wish of a heart patient in need of corrective heart surgery come true, but will have fun in giving. The coins placed in the aunching ramps of the wishing wells will spin around the vortex and increase in speed until it disappears at the base of the well. Donation collected will go towards Gift Of Life Penang Programme and benefit needy heart patients from infant to 60 years of age.



2005 – Dr. J Earl Gardner Fund



Dr. J Earl Gardner Fund was set up in honour of our founder who worked tirelessly to serve the community. In reflecting his passionate and selfless service, Dr J Earl Gardner Fund is set up to assist needy patients suffering from chronic illnesses in area of cleft palate repair, scoliosis, stroke, and major surgeries. To-date, the fund has disbursed more than RM3,000,000 to assist needy patients.

2012 – Cancer Fund

Specific to its purpose, cancer fund was set up to provide medical assistance to needy cancer patients to undergo cancer treatments. The fund kicked off with various fundraising events and one very notable event was “88 Shining Heads” Charity Go Bald and Food Fair. With the ardent support from the community, RM900,318 was raised. To-date, the fund has disbursed more than RM700,000 to help needy cancer patients who sought treatment at PAH Oncology Centre.

HPH 2nd CYCLE (2017 – 2021)

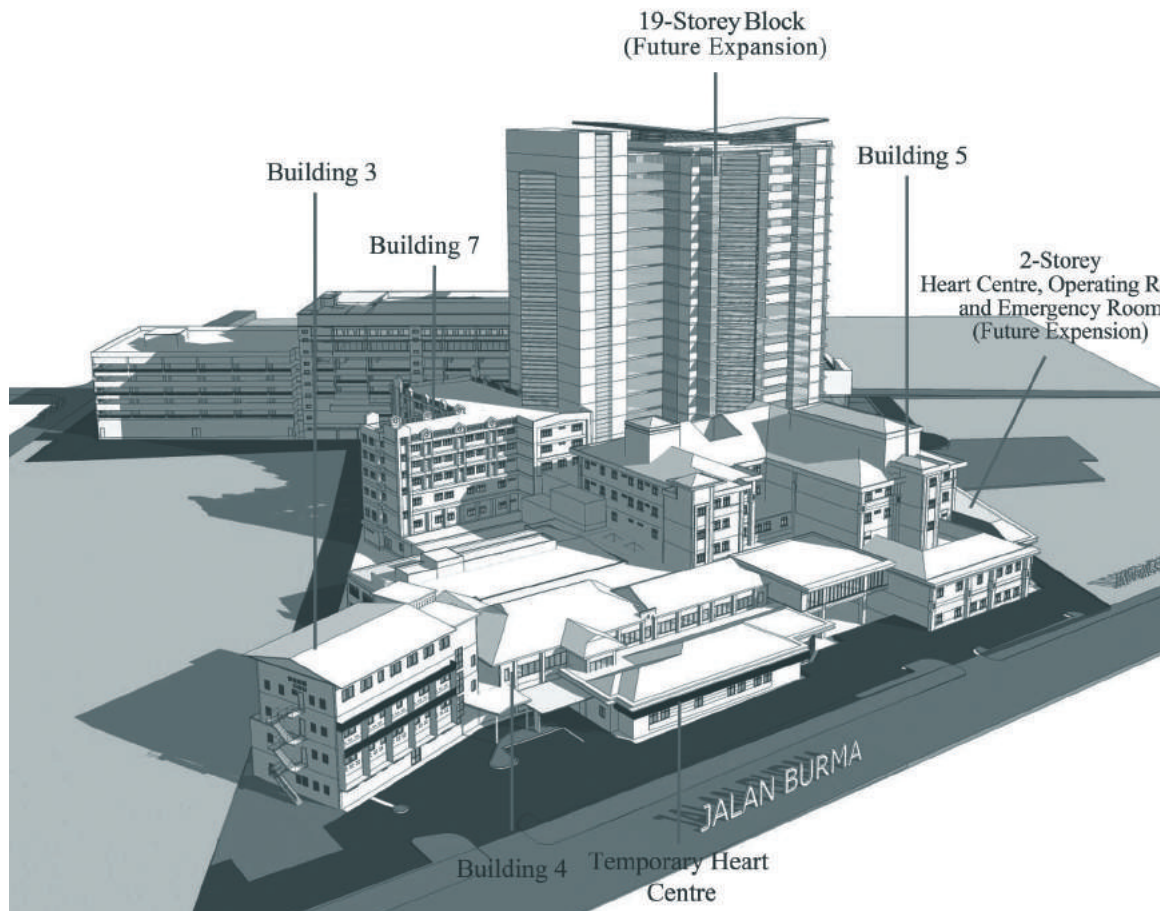

As an accredited HPH hospital, PAH strives to achieve better health gain for our patients and staff with an integrated and compressive health promotion services.



Blue Ribbon Campaign Award 2nd Cycle (2018 - 2020)

The campaign was officially launched at the 15th World Conference on Tobacco or Health in the 20 to 24 March 2012 in Singapore aims to recognize and appreciate the contributions of individuals, groups, organizations, government agencies but also to anyone who has contributed to the World Health Organization Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (WHO FCTC) for free environment cigarette smoke. Ministry of Health, Malaysia as a part of WHO Western Pacific Region had implement this campaign under its Statutory Body MySihat in Malaysia since 2016.

EVENTS & MILESTONES OF THE HOSPITAL



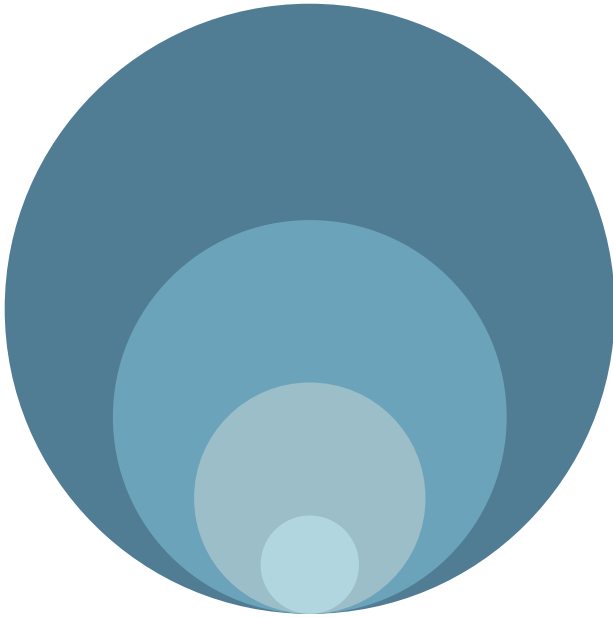
New Adventist Heart Centre (April 2018)

The newly expanded Adventist Heart Centre on April 2nd, marking yet another important milestone in PAH's history. The new state-of-the-art facility is equipped with 10 consultation rooms and 8 new procedure rooms, which also feature additional space for a rapid patient assessment. The new space also includes two counselling cum education rooms for patients to learn how to take better charge of their health to reduce their risk of contracting future heart problems.

Fully Automated EWS System (October 2018)

Penang Adventist Hospital (PAH) selected Philips Healthcare's IntelliVue Guardian Solution to provide a fully automated early warning scoring system (EWS) in our management of patient care. This makes PAH the first hospital in Malaysia to integrate the system with its existing Hospital Information System (HIS). We are also the only hospital in Asia Pacific to implement the largest coverage of a fully automated EWS system for 214 in-patient beds, which includes Medical 1A, 1B, 2, 3, 5, Surgical 1 & 2, Paediatric Ward and Maternity Ward.

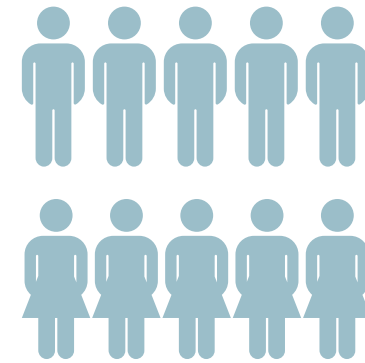

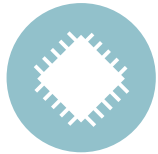

WELFARE FUND

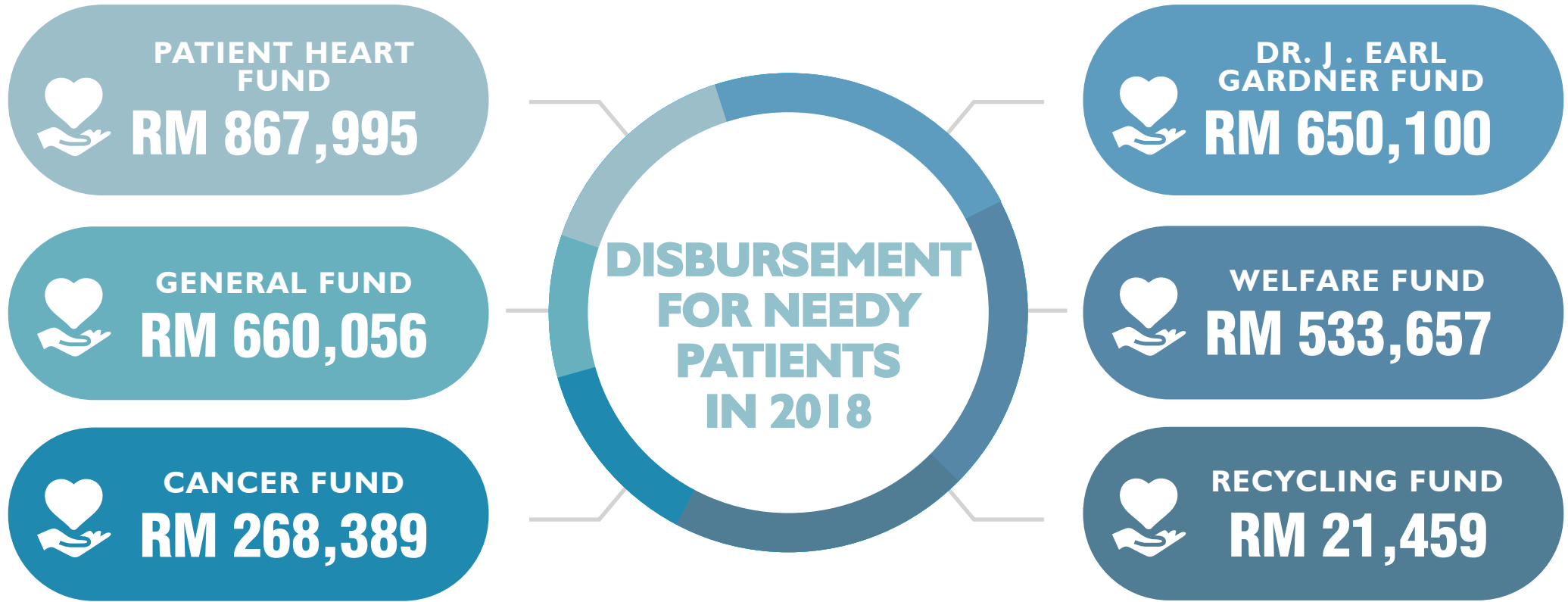

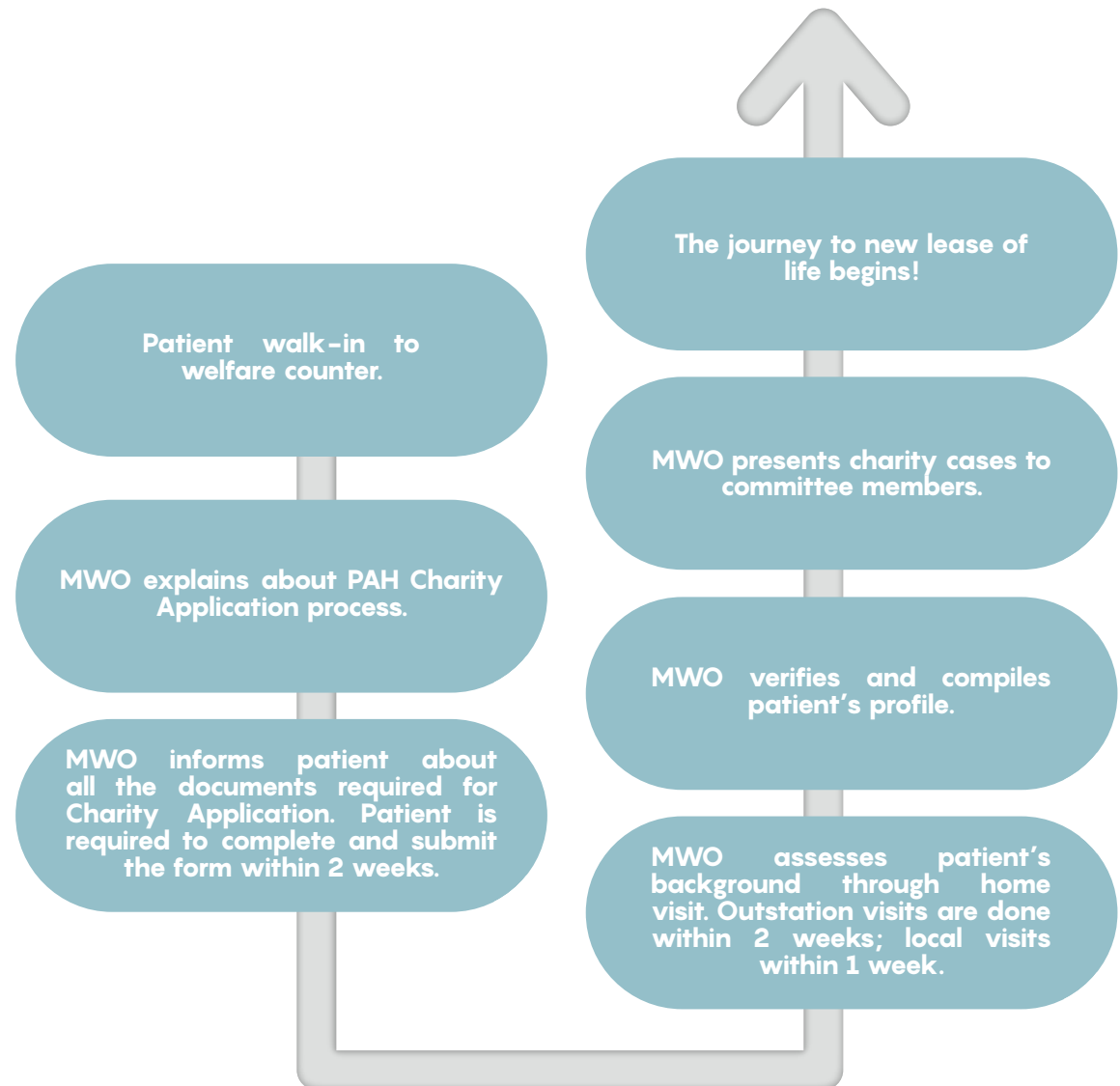
The Medical Welfare Services

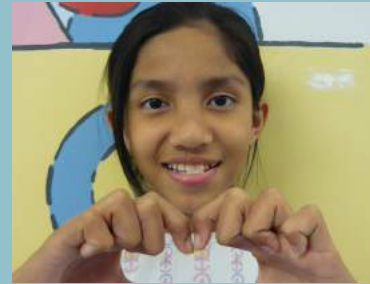
The hospital's Medical Welfare Services Unit was established in 1997 to help the poor and needy patients with financial assistance.

The Medical Welfare Services team assists patients and/or patients' relatives in seeking the appropriate healthcare treatment in PAH. The Medical Welfare Officer also liaises with doctors, nurses, other health professionals, as well as community resources and welfare agents in providing solutions for patients who are unable to meet medical costs. The Medical Welfare Services team is a caring and responsive team that serves people who are sick and hurting physically, mentally, spiritually, or socially through counseling and other support services. As responsible stewards of the charity funds, the team ensures that there is accountability and visibility for each case that is presented to the relevant committee for fund disbursement.

Charity Application Procedure

YOUR LOVE AND KINDNESS SPARKS HOPE

Every parent long for the arrival of their new born. Their sincere hope is for their adorable new born to grow up healthily. That was not the case of baby Jian Hao. Hardly 2 weeks of his birth with body weight of less than 2kg; he was diagnosed with hole in the heart!

This news comes as a big blow to his new parents; Mr & Mrs Lim. Their dream of happy, healthy birth and starting a new family was dashed within moments. They had to endure the heart pain of seeing their first born being administered with oxygen tube, intravenous drip, cooped in an incubator and most of all not being able to cuddle their first born!

Paediatric Cardiologist advised Mr & Mrs Lim that Jian Hao will require a surgery when he is stabilized and grow to more than 4kg in weight. The operation will cost approximately RM70,000. Mr & Mrs Lim was at a complete loss on how to help little Jian Hao. The high surgery cost is certainly out of reach for the new parent!

With the support of PAH Patient Heart Fund, Jian Hao underwent successful heart operations on 27th March. Jian Hao's case is a great testament of the various organisations coming together to assist a needy patient. Rasa Sayang Resort and Spa, Gift of Life program and Patient Heart Fund collectively disbursed RM52,000 for the little Jian Hao. Within a week of surgery, the little fighter, baby Jian Hao is finally in the arms of his loving parents and comfortably back at their home.

Our sincere appreciation to all donors, partners and various organisations for your partnership. Your love and support has enabled little Jian Hao to grow up healthily and explore what life brings.

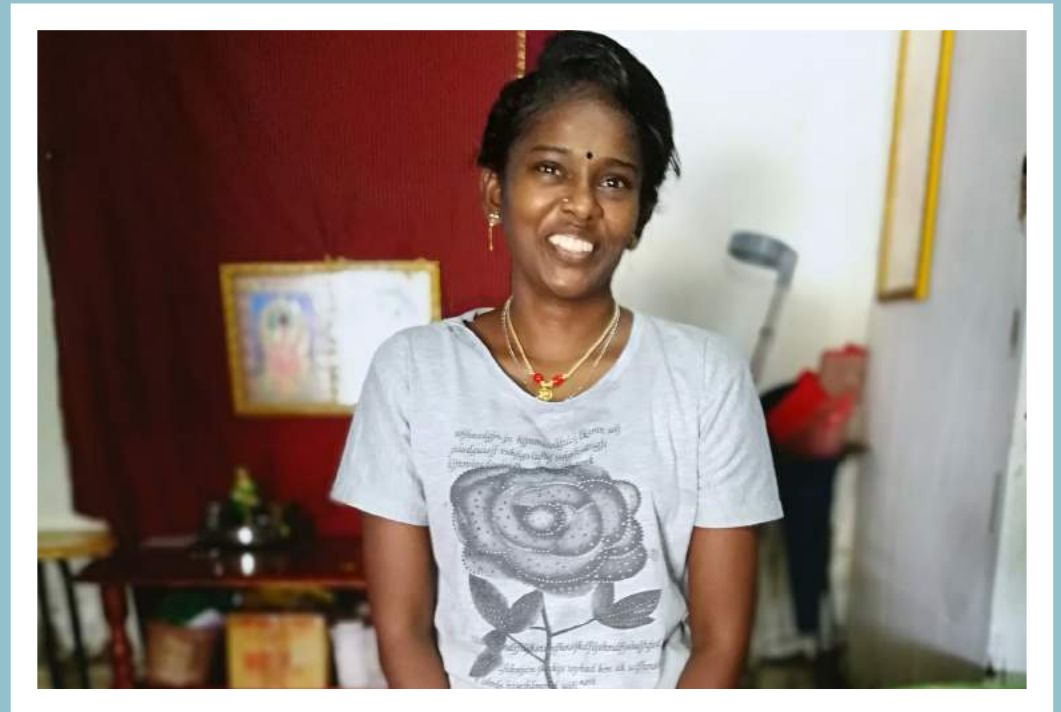


ANOTHER DAY TO BE GRATEFUL FOR

23 year old Thana was diagnosed with diabetes at a young age of 18. Having to take daily insulin injections has become a routine for her. Both her parents had passed away leaving behind Thana and her older brother who has been taking care of her. A couple of months ago Thana developed a wound on her right foot which had pus. After consulting with various doctors in different hospitals, they recommended that she amputate her leg. She was reluctant to amputate as she wanted to save her leg as much as possible.

Thana came to PAH for consultation with the hope to save her leg. Thana was admitted to treat her severe foot wound with antibiotics and daily dressing. By the grace of God she did not need to amputate her leg and was thrilled about it. The committee approved a total of RM 23, 470 for her admission and follow up treatments.

Thana is currently recovering very well. She is able to walk slowly on her own with a walker. She is overjoyed that her leg was able to be saved and is grateful and blessed for the help that had been rendered to her. God heals and we as his hands help to serve those around us.

A YOUNG MAN'S JOURNEY TO RECOVERY

Kean Lip is a 22 year old cheerful young man who finds every opportunity to expose himself with hands on experience at a nearby motor repair shop to gain more knowledge on automotive repair.

On a fine morning in June, Kean Lip was riding his motorcycle heading to a motorcycle shop to help as usual. While on his way, he was knocked down by an oncoming car. Kean Lip was flung off his motorcycle and injured his head, left leg and a few other spots. He was unconscious on the spot. He was send to GH and doctor diagnosed that Kean Lip has blood clod in the brain, 2 torn veins at the left leg and bruises all round.

Kean Lip underwent immediate surgery at GH to remove blood clot. Due to the severity of his condition and swelling of his brain, part of his skull could not be placed back. Kean Lip was required to recuperate and monitor his condition for a few months before his skull placement operation.

After 7 months of recuperating, Kean Lip was scheduled to undergo skull placement surgery however, renovation of operating theater at General Hospital pushed his surgery date by another 3 months. A mother's heart

ache seeing the condition of her son. Kean Lip has been house bound since his surgery, ashamed of his appearance. Besides his appearance, the main concern is shrinkage of brain if the placement of skull surgery were further delayed. Knowing that their financial situation may not permit them to seek treatment at a private hospital, Kean Lip's mum has no choice but to pursue this option for the sake of her son. Upon consultation with our surgeon, Kean Lip was indeed in good health to undergo skull placement surgery. Kean Lip obtained RM17,000 in medical charity for his surgery.

Today, Kean Lip is still recuperating at home, but life has been brighter for this young man. Kean Lip is expected to complete his final semester of automotive course soon. The family is grateful for the assistance given. Penang Adventist Hospital will not be able to play the role if not for the support of all parties who believed in our charity work.

WE CAN, I CAN



Mrs. Lee was diagnosed with stage 4 cervical cancer in 2015. Having to go through this journey without her husband who passed away 7 years ago due to lung cancer wasn't an easy one. She had been working as a wantan mee seller for years but had to stop working due to her illness. Her illness did not bring her down. She has been a very strong woman over the past few years not only because she has been independent but also because she has been

taking care of her son who is mentally challenged. In 2015 Mrs. Lee had gone through chemotherapy and radiotherapy. There was a sense of rejuvenation!

For 2 years she was doing well but unfortunately in 2017 the cancer reoccurred. She underwent second round of chemotherapy and radiotherapy. Unfortunately, she had to stop chemotherapy as it was causing terrible side effects. Despite the challenges that she faced, she managed to pull through and continued treatment with radiotherapy. The treatments have been expensive and she wanted to be referred to a government hospital as she could not afford her medical expenses. Before she could be transferred, she was advised to go through CT scan first to review the condition of her illness. Sadly the results showed that her cancer had spread to her lungs.

Throughout her journey since 2015 till to-date, the cancer fund has approved RM 60,770 to subsidized her cancer treatment expenses. Today, she is still fighting cancer with her head held high. It is not an easy road to go through but with the support of loved ones and prayer, we hope that she would be cheered up. Let us pray that she will be able to recover with the help of God and doctors.

GIVING BACK TO THE COMMUNITY

“ I am utmost grateful that through the support of Charity Department of Penang Adventist Hospital, I am able receive and complete my cancer treatment. I am most happy that I can now give back to the community by volunteering my time and effort to visit families who are needy. ” exclaimed Tan Siew Kheng.

I went through a tough journey fighting against the dreaded big C. I was diagnosed of cancer of the neck in 2015. Naive and with no clear thought, I decided not to receive any proper treatment but self-treat myself using various natural products. It did not take long for the cancer to develop.

Three years down the road, the lump on my neck grew bigger. I was very depressed with how I look as I stare at the mirror every morning! The thought of the lump growing and my worst fear came over me. With a heavy heart, I sort consultation with Oncologists at Penang Adventist Hospital. My heart sank as the oncologist confirmed that cancer had spread to my liver and it is at third stage. Radiation & chemotherapy were needed.

I was faced with another worrisome news; my insurance, with the minimal coverage that I had would not be sufficient to cover my treatment cost. I was at a lost. I had stop work since I was diagnosed with cancer and my saving has been depleting! It was thru my family’s financial support that I can make ends meet. The thought of giving up the cancer treatment did cross my mind constantly! Financially I simply do not have any means!

It was not until I was introduced to the medical social officers of the hospital that I feel a sense of hope. The committee deliberated my case and RM20,000 was disbursed to assist me with balance of payment from what my insurance could not cover. Few weeks after I completed my treatment, I am thankful that every morning I am able to take time to exercise, resume my volunteer work in helping needy patients and sharing their pain which I had gone through!

DEALING WITH DIFFICULTIES

The life of a dialysis patient is never easy as it is a lifetime treatment of removing toxins, excess water and solutes from the blood in who's kidneys do not perform these functions naturally. Mr. Mun has been a dialysis patient for the past 2 years and goes for dialysis three time a week. Even at the age of 59, he does not let his lifetime disease of end stage renal failure get in the way of trying to live a normal life.

His determination to be active does not get in his way as he still goes back to work once, he is done with dialysis treatment. A person with such persistence should be admired for his dedication in supporting his family. He is a father of 3 daughters and has to think about how to support the family. The cost for dialysis per month is usually more

than RM 2,000 which has been a burden for Mr. Mun.

He soon discovered that Penang Adventist Hospital has a charity department which has funds that helps patients who can't afford their medical bills with financial aids. With the financial assistance that has been approved for Mr. Mun under the Welfare Fund, he is able to manage his finances for dialysis treatments. He remains active in work as well as living a healthier lifestyle. We are glad to see the progress that Mr. Mun has gone through and pray for the best for him and his family.



WELFARE FUND SUPPORTS THE COMMUNITY



Madam Clara has been surrounded by love from her grandchildren, children and husband. In 2018 an unexpected circumstance occurred when she was diagnosed with H1N1. She was admitted and had to be put into isolation. 3 days later she was discharged but was not 100% well. Over the next month she had been in and out of the hospital as she had difficulties breathing, nausea and vomiting. The doctor attending to Madam Clara decided to have a thorough examination which included a colonoscopy.

The results from her colonoscopy showed that she had diverticulitis which is an inflammation or infection of small pouches called diverticula that develops along the walls of the intestines. At the same time, she was also diagnosed with a strain of bacteria called MRSA (Methicillinresistant Staphylococcus Aureus). She had to be admitted back into isolation and was on doses of antibiotics.

Unfortunately the medical bill in total had surpassed the family's financial capabilities and they had difficulties to pay the remaining amount. RM 35,439.06 was approved by the Welfare Fund Committee for Madam Clara's outstanding bill. She has fully recovered and is back to being the loving and gentle person that she is taking care of her family. Madam Clara is truly and forever grateful for the assistance that has been given. Her prayers have been answered and she continues to be the pillar of her family. Madam Clara and family thanks all those who were involved in the process of helping her get better and is blessed to be given the opportunity to be a testimony to those around her.

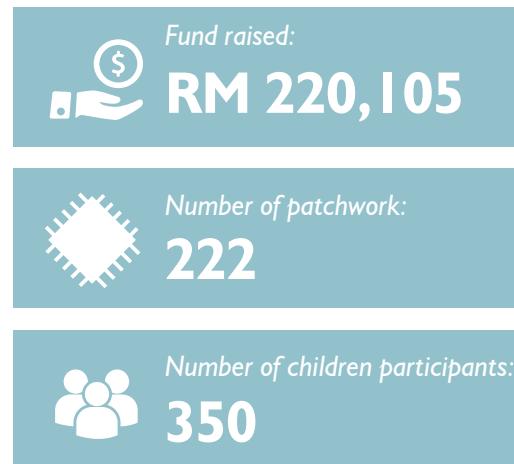

We reinvest revenue in excess of expenses to enhance our capacity to deliver high quality healthcare to the community we serve.
