MESSAGE FROM GROUP PRESIDENT

The very first iteration of Penang Adventist Hospital existed as Mission Clinic, set up on Muntri Street in 1924. Even all those years ago, the concept of “poor treated free” wasn’t an afterthought, instead it was the basis of the hospital’s values. Mission Clinic saw a revolving door of interesting patients, and not all of them could afford treatment. Still, the doctors and staff were determined to treat them, and the patients paid how they were able to, one going as far as to offer to carry his doctor’s coffin when he passed.

Mission Clinic developed a reputation in the community for helping those in need, and this is what allowed it to expand into a hospital. Back then, funds were short, and it was decided that the money would be gathered by solicitation. The money needed was raised from local towkays and people from all walks of life, all showing their appreciation for Dr Gardner’s work. Even back then, we embodied the words “by the community, for the community”.

Following the war and the Japanese occupation, economic difficulties were rife amongst the community, and Penang Adventist Hospital did not abandon their principles. The records show that many patients were treated free.

This continued throughout the 70s to the 2010s, numerous funds were set up to raise money to help the needy, such as the Patient Heart Fund, the Dr. J. Earl Gardner Fund and the Cancer Fund, which allow for free or subsidies treatment for those who can’t afford it.

At the height of the Covid pandemic, Penang Adventist Hospital didn’t shy away from their core values, instead going out of their way to ensure that they supported the needy and the community during this difficult time. During this time, 20 free heart surgeries were offered to help clear the backlog in Penang General Hospital. The fund also distributed daily essentials to the needy and frontline workers.

Today, Penang Adventist Hospital stands as an icon of healthcare in the country, in fact it remains the oldest, continuous form of Seventh Day Adventist medical work in the Far East. When Penang Adventist Hospital first opened its doors in 1924, I don’t think anyone would ever have imagined that we’d be celebrating its 100th anniversary. The facade of the building has certainly changed, going from shop house lot to buildings of sleek white walls and shiny chrome. The environment it works against has similarly changed as well, seeing how the world and its people have changed over a century. But one thing that stays the same without a doubt is the core value of the hospital. The buildings may change, the era may change, but no matter how the situation has differed, the hearts of the staff and the goal of the hospital has remained steadfast: to help the needy.

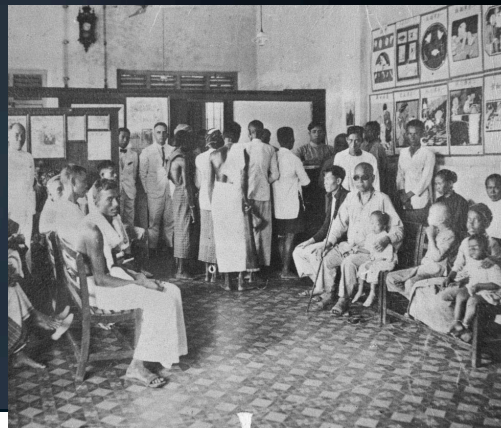

The fund has since then disbursed RM 13,397,759 given hope and a chance at new lease of life to needy heart patients whose ages ranged from a few weeks to 81 years old.

Medical Welfare Services

The hospital's Medical Welfare Services Unit was established in 1997 to help the poor and needy with financial assistance.

The Gift of Life is a community service project initiated by the Rotary Club of New York District 7250 in 1975. Since its inception, children with heart ailments from many developing countries have received chance at living normal lives and mended hearts.

In 1999, the Gift of Life Programme became a reality in Penang, through a matching grant from Gift of Life Inc. amounting to RM 370,000. This is a joint programme between the Rotary Club of Penang District 3300 as well as Penang Adventist Hospital. The hospital was granted as the referral base for all Gift of Life patients in Southeast Asia. Since 2014 Gift of Life Penang Programme extend its assistance to needy heart patients of 60 years and below. Till to-date, the Gift of Life Penang Programme has mended the hearts of 141 needy heart patients and disbursed RM 2,442,932

Cancer Fund

Specific to its purpose, cancer fund was set up to provide medical assistance to needy cancer patients to undergo cancer treatments. The fund kicked off with various fundraising events and one very notable event was “88 Shining Heads” Charity Go Bald and Food Fair. With the ardent support from the community, RM 900,318 was raised. To-date, the fund has disbursed RM 3,295,117 to help needy cancer patients who sought treatment at PAH Oncology Centre.

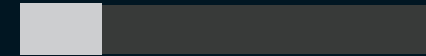

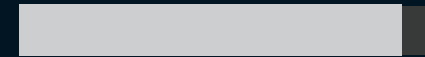

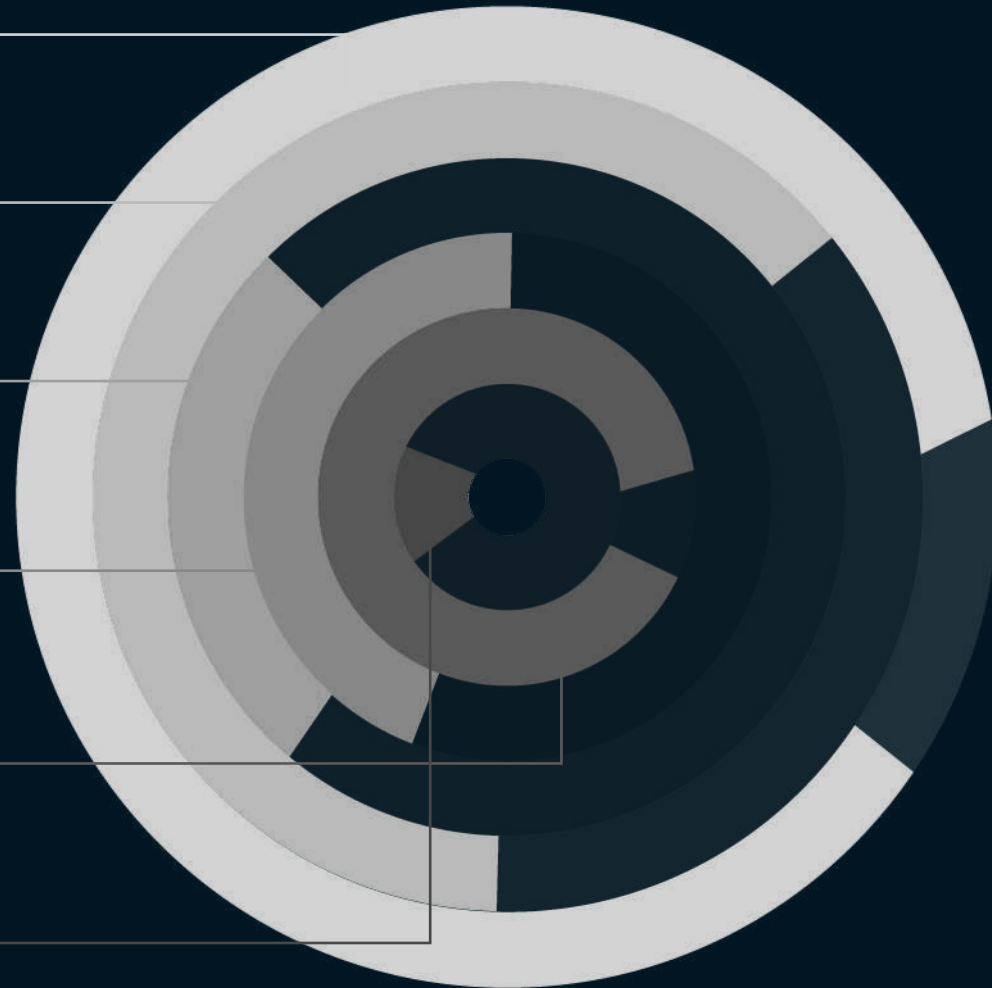

The Medical Welfare Services

The hospital's Medical Welfare Services Unit was established in 1997 to help the poor and needy with medical assistance.

The Medical Welfare Services team assists patients and/or patients' relatives in seeking the appropriate healthcare treatment in PAH. The Medical Welfare Officer also liaises with doctors, nurses, other health professionals, as well as community resources and welfare agents in providing solutions for patients who are unable to meet medical costs. The Medical Welfare Services unit is a caring and responsive team that serves the local community who are in need of medical assistance by offering medical financial aid.

As responsible stewards of the charity funds, the team ensures that there is accountability and visibility for each case that is presented to the relevant committee for fund disbursement.

Eye Check Screening at Silver Jubilee Home



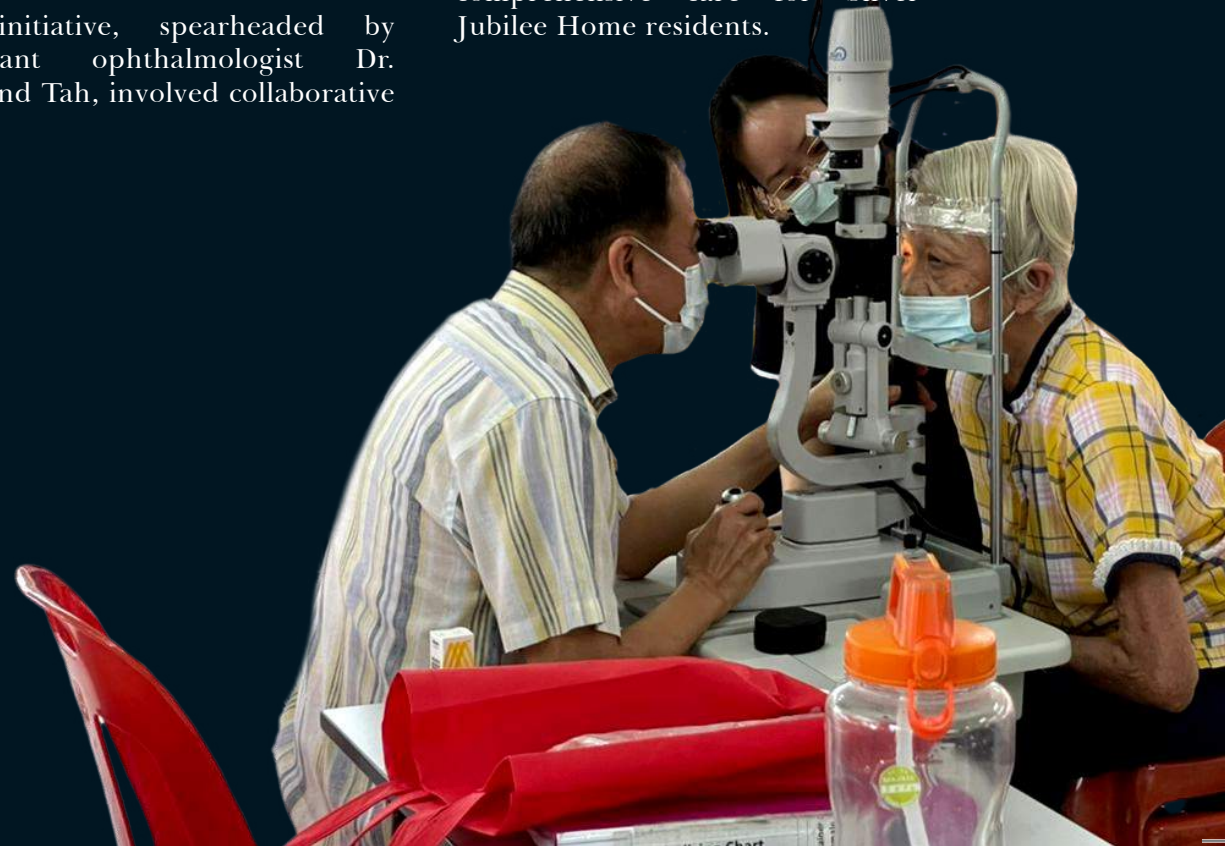
Penang Adventist Hospital marked World Health Day by extending a health screening program to Silver Jubilee Home residents, addressing vital health metrics like height, weight, BMI, blood pressure, glucose levels and eye examinations.

Out of the 60 screened with the aid of home nurses, one-third were diagnosed with cataracts. The Charity Team stepped in, facilitating interview and supporting free cataract surgery applications.

The initiative, spearheaded by consultant ophthalmologist Dr. Raymond Tah, involved collaborative

efforts from the Community Health and Charity Department, as well as dedicated nursing students. The success of this project was underlined during a press conference attended by esteemed figures like Tan Sri Dato' Seri Tan Kok Ping, Executive Advisor & Trustee of Silver Jubilee Home and Dato Loh Yeow Boo, Chairman of Silver Jubilee Home.

In total, over RM 92,000 from Welfare Fund was allocated for 20 cataract surgeries, ensuring comprehensive care for Silver Jubilee Home residents.

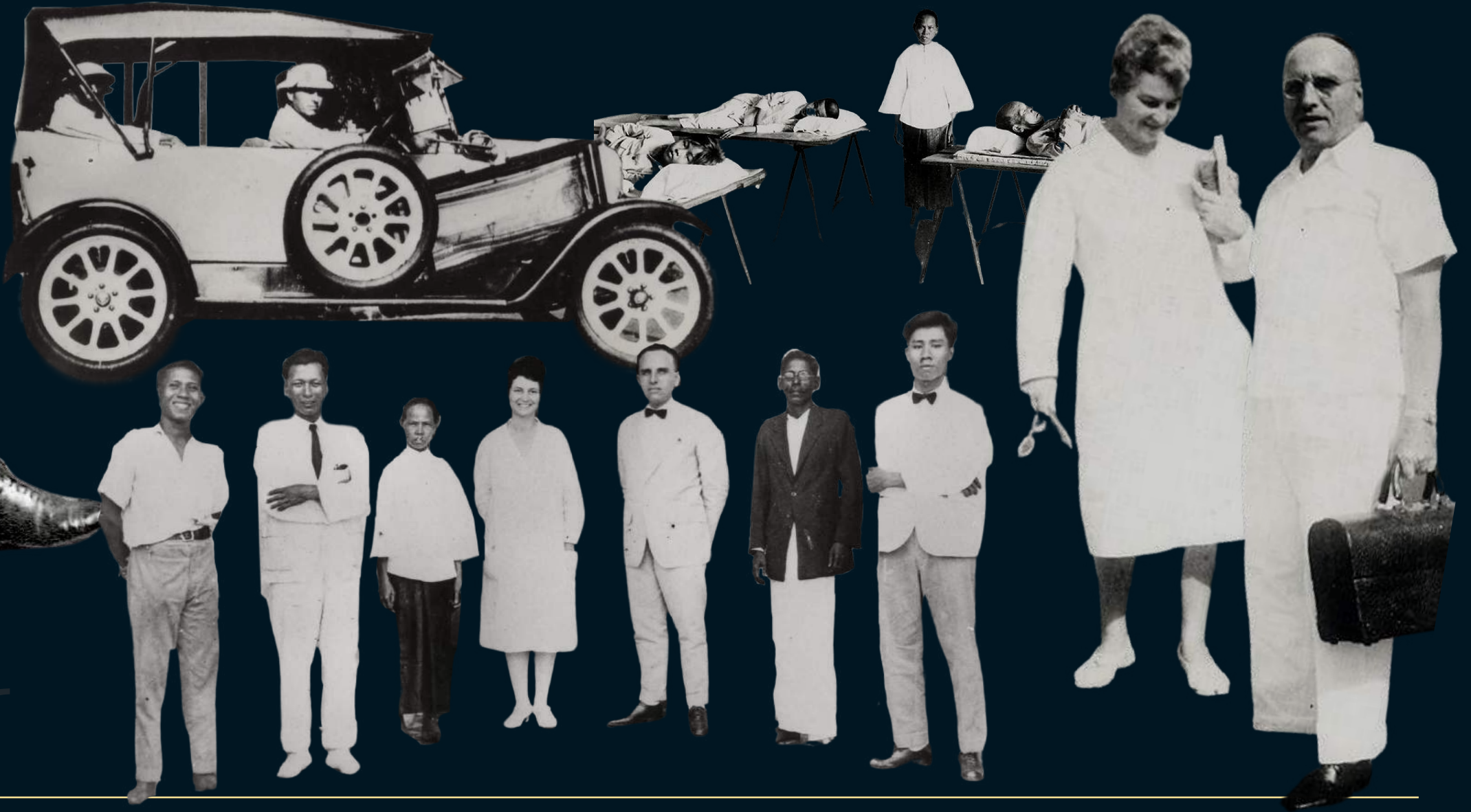

Surviving the Fire

In the midst of his routine as a soy milk hawker, Mr. Chua faced an unexpected gas explosion, **scalding him with 40% second-degree flame burns**. Recalling the incident, he shared how the pain hit instantly, an uninvited guest that left him in intense suffering.

He was rushed to a nearby clinic. The severity of his condition demanded more than what the clinic could offer. With insurance coverage, they swiftly chose Penang Adventist Hospital as the beacon of hope. The aftermath of the accident left him with severe burns on his face, neck, back, and upper limbs, leading to a 25-day hospital stay.

Medical interventions, including wound debridement and split-thickness skin grafts, became a vital part of his journey. The isolation room, which was necessary for his recovery, also contributed to the accumulating bill, totaling RM 126,027.95, surpassing his insurance coverage. Upon discovering the charitable support provided by the hospital, his daughter applied for assistance, and the charity **disbursed RM35,000**, significantly alleviating the financial strain.

Gratitude filled the air as Mr. Chua steadily recovered. The joy within the family mirrored his progress - from enduring deep pain since the incident in September 2023, to gradually being able to walk with assistance, and eventually taking short trips to enjoy nature's beauty, it takes only 4 months to witness such remarkable progress. Although he couldn't return to work immediately due to lifting restrictions, his positive outlook promised a return to normal life.

Witnessing the transformative power of assistance in their lives, Mr. Chua's family reciprocated by contributing to the hospital's fund, creating a heartening circle of support within the PAH community.

The Ultimate Battle

It was 2016 when Madam Hoo began to suspect something was amiss. Frequent sickness, fatigue, and weakness prompted her to seek medical help. A CT scan revealed advanced **liver cancer**. Her doctor informed her that she would have just a few months to live. Observing her today reveals little trace of the intense battle she fought against cancer. We admire her energy and spirit, and how she stands strong and determined to face her challenges. She shared with us, “After overcoming this, I will return to work. I want to earn money to repay my relatives who have generously supported me in covering my treatment expenses.”

Looking at her complex medical history, it is clear that the expenses were significant. A known Hepatitis B carrier, she has a history of stage 2 breast cancer, for which she underwent endocrine therapy, and a previous history of hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC) treated with surgery and radiofrequency ablation (RFA). The treatment costs have largely been shouldered by her younger sister. Her family consistently offers words of encouragement. She reflected, “None of them are giving up on me, how can I give up on myself?” Unfortunately, liver cancer has affected not only her but also other family members, claiming the lives of some relatives. The family is determined not to lose another member, supporting her all the way.

She began seeking treatments at Penang Adventist Hospital in 2023. Dr Ang recommended her to undergo 3-weekly immunotherapy and targeted therapy, planning for a year. Each session costs approximately RM 17,700. Although she sought to transfer to General Hospital after four sessions, she was informed that such treatment is unavailable there. Caught between the financial strain and the decision to continue, she has even put her house up for sale. Fortunately, the Penang Adventist Hospital Charity Fund (PAHCF) committee members collectively agreed to **disburse a maximum of RM50,000 (16.6% of the estimated cost)** for her treatments.

Her condition is under control thus far, and we remain hopeful that Madam Hoo’s journey ahead will be filled with strength and moments of joy.

Undeterred, Mr. Lew sought treatment at various hospitals, navigating the complex composition of his medical condition. By October 2023, he faced lower limb weakness and incontinence, leading to a diagnosis of **Metastatic Colorectal Cancer with a T3 compression fracture, indicating the spread to his spine.**

Under the expertise of Dr. Tan Chun Ee, Mr. Lew underwent spine surgery, confronting his inner struggles with bravery. His battle continued at Penang Adventist Hospital, where he received chemotherapy and radiotherapy treatments under the care of Dr. Fabian, **with financial support from the Cancer Fund totalling RM 26,727.43.**

"In life, it's not where you go, but who you go with." Gratefully, Mr. Lew is not traversing this path alone. He is blessed with a circle of steadfast friends who offer unwavering support and companionship. Their presence in his life is a source of deep appreciation. Expressing heartfelt thanks, Mr. Lew also acknowledges the professional care provided by the doctors and nurses at Penang Adventist Hospital, recognizing their dedication and expertise throughout his courageous battle.

Despite being called back by the Lord, Mr. Lew's refusal to surrender and his exploration of every treatment option despite facing serious health challenges stand as a testament to resilience. His spirit lives on in the hearts of those who knew him, reminding us all to cherish each moment of life.

Relief came in the form of a charitable **reimbursement of RM 8,000**, alleviating some of the financial strain.

Thankfully, the surgery was a resounding success, heralding a new lease on life for Mr. Lim. His recovery was swift, and with each passing day, he grew more appreciative of life’s fragility, prioritizing his health above all else. Weekends now find him strolling hand in hand with his wife, savoring the simple joys of togetherness. Encik Zamzamin Bin Hamid, seorang bapa, yang berusia 55 tahun kepada tiga orang anak dan pencari nafkah utama untuk keluarganya, menjalani kehidupan aktif yang penuh dengan kegiatan luar seperti berbasikal, mendaki, dan berjoging. Namun, pada bulan Jun 2023, masalah pedih ulu hati yang kelihatan tidak berbahaya membawa kepada diagnosis Penyakit Jantung Iskemik dengan enam sekatan. Inilah permulaan perjalanan yang mencabar bagi Encik Zamzamin & sekeluarga.

Walaupun begitu, Encik Zamzamin kekal optimistik dan terus mendapat konsultasi dengan pakar jantung di pelbagai hospital. Tetapi, beliau terasa kecewa dan kehilangan semangat apabila sedar bahawa sesetengah hospital tidak dapat melakukan pembedahan yang diperlukan.

Di tengah-tengah kemurungan, seorang kawan mencadangkan pakar jantung, Dr. Tan Chiang Soo di Penang Adventist Hospital. Ini, memberikan secercah harapan kepada Encik Zamzamin sekali lagi. Namun, satu cabaran baru muncul – kekurangan wang. Insuransi Encik Zamzamin memang tidak mencukupi untuk menampung kos rawatan yang tinggi, menimbulkan keraguan sama ada dia mampu menjalani pembedahan yang akan menyelamatkan nyawanya.

Demi mengatasi keraguannya, Encik Zamzamin memohon bantuan amal dari Penang Adventist Hospital, satu keputusan yang menjadi titik perubahan dalam perjuangannya melawan penyakit jantung. Dengan kelulusan bantuan dana hospital, beliau menjalani dua pembedahan Percutaneous coronary intervention yang Berjaya. Dana Pesakit Jantung hospital Adventist, **menyokong sebanyak RM 31,748.95 (35.79%) daripada kos pembedahan.**

Hari ini, dengan pembedahan yang berjaya dan semangat yang bertekad, Encik Zamzamin kembali kepada gaya hidup aktifnya. Beliau bersyukur dapat membuktikan yang rawatan perubatan dan sokongan amal dapat mengubah hidup. Tharmidzy's Path to Recovery



Tharmidzy, a dedicated 32-year-old workaholic, always went above and beyond to tackle tasks and put in long hours to provide for his small family. Despite his demanding schedule, he made it a point to be there for his loved ones whenever they needed him.

One evening, Tharmidzy was on his way to complete some errands on his motorbike before reuniting with his young children. In a split-second decision to avoid an elderly pedestrian standing in the middle of the road, he ended up falling from his bike. **The accident left him with multiple abrasions on his hands, forearms, and knees, as well as a laceration on his left forehead.** In severe pain, he was swiftly transported to the nearest government medical facilities by ambulance.

Hours passed as Tharmidzy waited for treatment at the medical facilities, his discomfort mounting, particularly around his eyes. Despite his pleas for urgent attention, he was unable to receive immediate care. His wife, who had recently given birth to their newborn, was distraught seeing her husband's condition. Realizing they might not afford further treatment, at GH, they made the difficult decision to transfer him to a private hospital (PAH) Accident and Emergency department.

Upon arrival at PAH, Tharmidzy underwent primary suturing for his laceration. However, the shock came when they were presented with the total bill. Aware of their financial constraints, they opted for Tharmidzy to discharge himself against medical advice. With their backs against the wall, they scrambled to borrow money from various sources to settle the mounting medical expenses. Eventually, **Tharmidzy was able to secure RM 5,647.75 in medical charity to help alleviate the burden.**

After a month-long recovery, Tharmidzy returned to work and resumed his role as a playful and loving father to his children. Despite the challenges, he felt immense gratitude towards the doctors at PAH for their kindness, especially for dressing his wounds before his discharge, which turned out to be his final treatment. He also appreciated the financial assistance provided, which helped them navigate through a difficult time with a sense of relief and hope for the future.

Brightening Lives: *A Vision Transformation with Charity Assistance*



Being a person with physical disabilities and unable to work, Ramasfary A/P Nachimuthu, a resilient 54-year-old facing the added challenge of blurry vision since 2022.

Blurred vision affected Madam Ramasfary's daily routine significantly. Simple tasks, such as seeing food on her plate or navigating stairs to her 3rd-floor flat, became challenging, leading to numerous falls.

Realizing her vision began deteriorating, Madam Ramasfary turned to a private clinic, which then referred her to a general hospital. However, the long waiting queues posed an obstacle, particularly as her vision worsened. Eventually, she sought help at Penang Adventist Hospital and consulted Dr. Raymond Tah Kheng Soon.

Recognizing the urgency of her condition, Madam Ramasfary underwent left eye surgery in August 2023, **with full charity assistance of RM 4,600**. Subsequently, Dr. Raymond Tah recommended another cataract surgery for her right eye due to a significant power difference between the eyes. This operation, performed in October 2023, **again supported with 100% charity assistance**.

Post-surgeries, Madam Ramasfary experienced a remarkable recovery. Her vision improved, greatly easing her daily routine and bringing immense joy. She describes everything as beautiful, with colours appearing vivid.

This transformation, achieved through medical welfare, emphasizes the significant impact even a modest contribution can make, providing hope for individuals facing challenges.
